The Department offers two types of MA in English for two different types of students:

i. MA (1 Year) in English:

It is offered for 4-year BA (Hons.) in English graduates from the same or other universities. A total 36 credits are offered into two semesters. This program is an advanced stage of learning to be pursued after the successful completion of a BA (Honors) degree in English. It further extends the critical skills of reading and analysis of texts developed in the undergraduate program. Students are expected to apply their reasoning and theoretical knowledge to establish their own views of the literature they read. This program also ensures the highest communicative competency by appropriate use of language and linguistics. A proper understanding of these courses will further develop their skills and prepare them to join the workforce with strong reasoning, communication, analytical ability and logical leadership through appropriate processing of information.

ii. MA (2 year) in English:

It is offered for 3-year BA (Pass) graduates and also for 4-year BA (Honors) graduates in subjects other than English. This Program covers 66 credit hours in total. It will extend students to learn experimentally through discussion, debate, and stimulating readings and assignments. Students are expected to increase analytical and critical thinking skills and enhance creative outlook to sharpen communication and professional skills. Graduates are expected to gain theoretical perspectives and apply the professional knowledge in their respective workforce. A proper understanding of these courses will further develop the learner's ability to understand different cultures and cope up with the continuous changes in the local and global arenas.

• 4-year BA (Honors) in English from a recognized university from home and abroad with minimum CGPA 2.50.

- 2.50 in HSC or Equivalent
- 2.50 in SSC or Equivalent
- ii) Requirement for MA (2 Year) in English:
- 4-year Honors degree in subjects other than English with CGPA 2.00 or,
- 3-year BA (Pass) degree with CGPA 2.50
- 2.50 in HSC or Equivalent
- 2.50 in SSC or Equivalent
